

Preparation Coordinator Report 2009 AGM

Autumn Preparation Burials & Retrievals

We have buried 8000 Horns for Horn Manure 500 Preparation in the Office site and 5000 Horns in the Glenifer site. Another 7000 Horns are going to be buried in May. This makes a total of 20000 Horns for Horn Manure 500 Preparation. From those Horns I am expecting 1300 kg of Horn Manure 500.

We also buried around 200 kilogram of Clay for Winter Horn Clay Preparation and some Basalt dust for Horn Basalt. Shane Martin is going to test the paramagnetic level every three months. Thanks to him we received highly paramagnetic basalt dust.

With the help of TAFE students who are studying organic farming, we made the Compost Preparations and revealed very good quality Nettle (504) Preparation that was buried for one year.

The office site seems too small for the expanding preparations activities. We have added another six large pits for making Manure Concentrate. I recommend leasing more land next to the office.

Preparation Quantities

- Horn Manure 500 - 1500 kg at office site
- Manure Concentrate - 700 kg
- Pre Mix - 150 kg
- Horn Basalt - 40 kg
- Winter Horn Clay - 100kg
- Horn Silica (501) - 90 kg
- Summer Horn Clay - 200 kg
- And all year round Horn Clay - 300 kg

We now have 15 pits full of Manure Concentrate that will be ready in 3 or 4 months and I will be filling another 10 pits in the coming months.

Quality control and storage of preparation

We check the moisture level in Horn Manure 500 preparation monthly and the compost preparations weekly.

Sales of Preparations

The total value of preparation sales from 1 January through December was \$318,281.45. The net income was \$63,125.55. The administration allocation from the preparation activity was \$114,281.45.
